Dedicated to Lord Vishnu and constructed in classic Dravidian architectural style, the temple's towering gopuram and gold-plated sanctum are awe-inspiring. Inside, the deity is seen reclining on the serpent Anantha, a representation unique to this shrine. The temple is also globally renowned for its mysterious underground vaults and priceless treasures; yet, its greatest gift is the profound spiritual calm it offers.

Continuing from Thiruvananthapuram, the road leads to Kovalam, a coastal town renowned for its serene atmosphere and picture-perfect beaches. Once known for its fishing community, the village now welcomes visitors drawn to its beaches and spiritual charm. As the coast unfolds before you, it invites gentle exploration, perhaps a boat ride through the lush backwaters to Poovar Island. The journey through narrow mangrove-lined channels, alive with birdcalls and the rhythmic splash of paddles, offers a peaceful prelude to Kerala's natural beauty and highlights the unique offerings of this Varkala Tour Package.



In Kovalam, coastal exploration takes centre stage. Begin with a walk along the crescent-shaped Kovalam Beach, where fishermen prepare their boats and the early sun paints the sky in soft colours. The palm-lined shore and rhythmic waves create a perfect setting for reflection. Hawa Beach, nearby, adds a dose of adventure, offering water sports like parasailing, surfing, and catamaran rides. For a quieter experience, beach shacks serve local snacks and fresh coconut water as you watch the sea roll in.

Not far from the beach, the Azhimala Shiva Temple rises on a cliff, overlooking the sea. A dramatic 58-foot-tall statue of Lord Shiva, with flowing hair and a serene expression, makes this a place of both devotion and awe. The combination of sacred energy and panoramic ocean views makes it a spiritual and visual highlight of the coastal route. Another must-visit is the Vizhinjam Lighthouse. Perched on a rocky cliff, its spiral staircase leads to a viewing platform that opens up to sweeping vistas of the Arabian Sea, waves crashing below, fishing boats dotting the horizon, and the sun melting into the ocean.

Northward along the coastline lies Varkala, Kerala's bohemian beach town, where cliffs meet the sea. Unlike other beaches in the region, Varkala's red laterite cliffs rise above the shoreline, lined with cafes, yoga centres, and boutique shops. This Varkala Tour Package ensures you have ample time to enjoy the pristine beach, explore cliffside cafes, and engage in yoga or meditation sessions. The beach itself is perfect for meditative walks or simply lounging with a good book. The town emanates a laid-back charm that appeals to backpackers and luxury travellers alike.

Kappil Beach, just north of Varkala, is a serene spot where the sea meets backwaters, creating a narrow stretch of land bordered by water on both sides. This rare landscape offers a perfect setting for nature lovers and photographers. It's an ideal location for a quiet retreat from the more popular tourist spots, included in this carefully curated Varkala Tour Package.

For those interested in history and spirituality, the Janardhanaswamy Temple in Varkala is a mustsee. With a history spanning over 2,000 years, perched atop a hill overlooking the sea, the temple is often referred to as the 'Benares of the South.' Dedicated to Lord Vishnu, it features stone pathways, ancient bells, and tranquil courtyards that resonate with devotional hymns and chants, offering a serene and spiritual experience.

The journey concludes in Kochi, a city renowned for its rich cultural fusion and colonial charm. Though serving as the departure point, Kochi itself is a destination worth exploring. Fort Kochi is a historic district where European, Chinese, and Indian influences merge beautifully.
