Adventure seekers can hike to Winch Camp, known for its panoramic views and quiet camping spots. From Barot, the journey continues to Bir Billing, famous for paragliding. Billing, the launch site, is perched high above the valley and offers a spectacular take-off point. Glide through the air and land in scenic Bir, where Tibetan monasteries, cafes, and mountain views await. Whether you're looking to relax by the river or soar above the Himalayas, this Barot Valley package delivers a balanced experience. With crisp mountain air, cosy stays, and moments of pure adrenaline, this trip is ideal for couples, solo travellers, or small groups. If you're tired of crowded hill stations and want something refreshing, this offbeat escape is just the adventure you need.

Things to do in Bir Billing

1. Trout Fishing in the Uhl River

- Barot is famous for trout fishing, especially in the clear waters of the Uhl River.
- You can rent fishing gear or get a license if you want to try angling yourself.

2. Nature Walks & Riverside Picnics

- Stroll along the riverbanks, through pine and deodar forests.
- Ideal for photography, meditation, or just breathing in the crisp mountain air.

3. Visit the Barot Dam & Shanan Hydel Project

- A peaceful place with scenic views and a small reservoir.
- Learn about one of India's oldest hydroelectric projects, started during British rule.

4. Hike to Winch Camp

- A short but scenic trek with panoramic views of the valley.
- Great spot for camping or stargazing on a clear night.

5. Explore Nargu Wildlife Sanctuary

- Located across the river, it's home to Himalayan monals, black bears, and leopards.
- Ideal for nature lovers and birdwatchers (go with a local guide).

6. Visit Lohardi Village

- A quaint Himachali village 6 km from Barot.
- Experience local culture, wooden homes, and untouched landscapes.

7. Bonfire & Local Cuisine

- Enjoy a cosy bonfire at your homestay or campsite.
- Try local Himachali dishes like siddu, rajma chawal, and trout curry.

8. Photography & Stargazing

- With minimal light pollution, Barot is excellent for astrophotography.
- Capture rustic village life, misty forests, and dramatic sunsets.

Itinerary •

Day 1: Delhi to Bir | Dist: 516 km | Time: 10 to 12 hrs | Altitude: 300 m to 1525 m

- You will begin your journey from Delhi, travelling in a private cab or an air-conditioned Volvo bus.
- The trip spans roughly 12 to 13 hours, treating you to scenic views throughout the journey.

Day 2: Reaching Bir and Paragliding | Arrival Time: 06 am to 08 am Check-In: 11:00 am

- Once you arrive in Bir, check into your hotel at the scheduled time.
- After freshening up, head to Billing for an unforgettable paragliding experience.
- In the evening, unwind by exploring the charming local cafes.

Day 3: Bir to Barot | Sightseeing Time: 12 pm to 06 pm

- Wake up to the serene sight of paragliders soaring across the sky.
- After freshening up and enjoying a hearty breakfast, check out of the hotel and leave for Barot Valley.
- After reaching, you will explore the Uhl River, Barot Dam, and Hydel Project.
- Explore Lohardi village or go for a short nature walk in the surrounding deodar forests.
- In the evening, enjoy a Bonfire & dinner at your stay. And enjoy the peaceful mountain ambience.

FAQs •

Q: Where can I find a Barot Valley map?

A:

You can use Google Maps – simply search “Barot, Himachal Pradesh.” Offline maps or Himachal road atlases also show the Barot Valley within the Mandi District.

Q: What is the current distance of Barot Valley from Delhi?

A:

The road distance between Delhi and Barot Valley is roughly 500 kilometres, with a travel time of approximately 10 to 12 hours, depending on traffic and road conditions.

Q: Is there a waterfall in Barot Valley?

A:

Yes! Ghatta Waterfall, located near Lohardi, is a beautiful, less-crowded spot ideal for short hikes and photography.

Q: How far is Delhi from Barot Valley?

A:

Approximately 500 km. The route is scenic but includes narrow mountain roads, so start early if driving.

Q: What is the distance from Barot to Rajgundha?

A:

Rajgundha lies about 22 km by road from Barot, via Baragran village. The remaining stretch from Baragran to Rajgundha covers 5–6 km on foot.

Q: How long is the trek from Barot to Rajgundha?

A:

While this route is now largely accessible by dirt road, you can still walk 5–6 km from Baragran. Formerly, this was considered the shortest trek option.
