The journey ends with a visit to Chamera Lake View Point, where you can take in the stunning views of the artificial reservoir formed by the Chamera Dam on the Ravi River. The return journey to Delhi concludes the tour, leaving behind unforgettable memories of spiritual experiences, breathtaking mountain landscapes, and cultural richness.

Places to Visit in Dalhousie Package

1. HPCA Cricket Stadium

Located in Dharamshala, this stadium is one of the highest in the world. With the Dhauladhar ranges in the background, it offers a stunning view and a unique experience, even if you're not a cricket enthusiast.

2. War Memorial

Surrounded by tall pine trees, the War Memorial in Dharamshala honours the brave soldiers who sacrificed their lives. It's a quiet, reflective place perfect for nature walks, historical reflection, and photography amid peaceful surroundings.

3. Tea Gardens

Dharamshala's lush tea gardens are perfect for peaceful walks and photography. These gently sloping estates showcase tea production while offering a refreshing escape into green serenity, ideal for nature lovers and those seeking quiet beauty.

4. Dalai Lama Temple (Tsuglagkhang Complex)

This tranquil temple serves as the Dalai Lama's residence and stands as a centre for Tibetan spirituality and cultural heritage. Prayer wheels, monks, and chanting create a tranquil spiritual atmosphere, making it a must-visit spot in McLeodganj.

5. Bhagsu Waterfall & Bhagsunath Temple

A short hike from McLeodganj leads to this refreshing waterfall and sacred temple dedicated to Lord Shiva. It's a popular destination for both spiritual seekers and trekkers seeking natural beauty and relaxation.

6. St. John in the Wilderness Church

This historic Anglican church is nestled in dense Deodar forests. Built in neo-Gothic style, it features beautiful stained-glass windows and offers peaceful surroundings away from the city's bustle.

7. Naddi View Point

Naddi is a peaceful hamlet located near McLeodganj, renowned for its stunning vistas of the snow-capped Dhauladhar mountains, best admired during the golden hours of sunrise and sunset.

8. Tibetan Market

This bustling market in McLeodganj is perfect for shopping for Tibetan handicrafts, souvenirs, jewellery, and woollens. It reflects the rich culture and craftsmanship of Tibetan refugees, making it a must-visit destination for unique shopping experiences.

9. Khajjiar

Nicknamed the “Mini Switzerland of India,” Khajjiar is renowned for its lush green meadows, dense forests, and serene lake. It’s ideal for picnics, horse riding, and simply enjoying nature at its most scenic.

10. Kalatop Wildlife Sanctuary

Located near Dalhousie, Kalatop is a dense forest reserve featuring hiking trails, deodar trees, and a rich array of wildlife. It’s a peaceful destination for trekking, birdwatching, and reconnecting with nature in a protected Himalayan environment.

11. St. John’s Church, Dalhousie

This historic British-era church is known for its colonial architecture and scenic location. Surrounded by pines, it offers a quiet spiritual experience with stained glass interiors and a glimpse into Dalhousie’s colonial past.

12. Beeji’s Park

A unique military-themed park in Dalhousie with war exhibits, helicopters, and tanks. It pays tribute to India’s armed forces and offers visitors a chance to learn about national defence in a beautifully maintained setting.

13. Chamera Lake

Formed by the Chamera Dam on the Ravi River, this lake is a scenic retreat ideal for boating and photography. Surrounded by hills, it’s a calm, beautiful stop during your Dalhousie visit.

Day 1: Delhi to Dharamshala | Distance: 472 km | Time: 09 to 10 hr | Altitude: 206m to 1500m

- Start your journey from Delhi at the given pickup point.
- Travel comfortably to Dharamshala by cab or Volvo bus.
- The scenic drive through the hills takes around 9 to 10 hours.
- Sit back, relax, and enjoy the overnight journey.

Day 2: Reaching Dharamshala | Arrival Time: 8:00 am | Check-In time: 11:00 am

- Arrive in Dharamshala and settle into your hotel to relax after the journey.
- In the evening, explore the colourful Tibetan Market and visit the peaceful Kalchakra and Dalai Lama Temple.
- Enjoy scenic spots such as Dal Lake, Naddi Hills, Bhagsu Waterfall, and St. John's Church.

Day 3: Dharamshala to Dalhousie | Distance: 118 km | Time: 05 to 07 hrs | Altitude: 1500 m to 1970 m

- Proceed on a scenic drive to Dalhousie, stopping at the peaceful Kalatop Wildlife Sanctuary en route.
- Once you reach Dalhousie, take time to relax and enjoy the peaceful views of the surrounding mountains.

Day 4: Dalhousie Local Sightseeing | Sightseeing Time: 05 to 07 hrs

- Visit the historic St. John Church and enjoy a peaceful stroll through Beeji's Park.
- End your day by exploring the lively markets of Dalhousie, then return to your hotel to unwind and rest.
