From spotting the majestic one-horned rhinoceros in Kaziranga National Park to exploring the living root bridges of Cherrapunji, this tour promises a perfect mix of nature, adventure, and culture.

Best Time to Visit

The best time to plan this Kaziranga and Meghalaya Package is from October to April, when Kaziranga is open for safaris and Meghalaya's waterfalls and landscapes are at their most vibrant.

Places to visit Kaziranga Package

1. Kaziranga National Park – Assam

Attractions & Highlights:

- One-Horned Rhinoceros: The biggest attraction of Kaziranga National Park is its large population of one-horned rhinoceros, accounting for more than two-thirds of the world's total population of this rare species.
- Jeep Safari: Explore the park's diverse zones (Kohora, Bagori, Agaratoli, Burapahar) for wildlife sightings.



- Elephant Safari: Experience close-up encounters with rhinos and deer in the early morning hours.
- Wildlife Spotting: Look out for elephants, wild buffalo, swamp deer, and tigers (if lucky).
- Birdwatching Paradise: Over 500 species of birds, including pelicans, storks, and eagles.
- Kaziranga Orchid Park: It's a vibrant cultural and floral centre featuring native orchid varieties, live artistic performances, and authentic traditional Assamese cuisine.

2. Shillong

Attractions & Highlights:

- Umiam Lake (Barapani): A scenic man-made lake perfect for boating and photography.
- Shillong Peak: The highest point in Meghalaya, offering panoramic city and mountain views.
- Elephant Falls: A three-step waterfall surrounded by lush greenery.
- Police Bazar: The main market area for shopping for souvenirs, handicrafts, and trying local food.
- Don Bosco Museum: An interactive museum showcasing the cultural heritage of Northeast India.
- Ward's Lake: A scenic lake located in the centre of Shillong, perfect for peaceful walks, relaxing by the water, or enjoying a paddle boating experience.

3. Cherrapunjee (Sohra)

Attractions & Highlights:

- Nohkalikai Falls: The tallest plunge waterfall in India, cascading from dramatic cliffs, making
 it a highlight of any trip to Cherrapunji.
- Seven Sisters Falls: A majestic seven-tiered waterfall, best viewed during the monsoon when all seven streams flow in full glory.
- Mawsmai Caves: Naturally formed limestone caves open for tourist exploration.



- Double Decker Living Root Bridge (Nongriat): A marvel of bioengineering and indigenous craftsmanship.
- Dainthlen Falls: A beautiful yet less crowded waterfall, known not just for its scenic beauty but also for the local legend associated with it.
- Eco Park: A serene spot offering sweeping views of the Bangladesh plains and surrounding waterfalls, perfect for nature walks and photography.

4. Dawki

Attractions & Highlights:

- Umngot River: Famous for its unbelievably clear waters, creating the illusion that boats are gliding through air.
- Boating in Dawki: A must-do activity where visitors can enjoy boat rides on the transparent waters of the Umngot River, making it one of Dawki's top attractions.
- India-Bangladesh Border at Dawki: Experience the friendly Indo-Bangladesh border at Tamabil.
- Suspension Bridge: An old British-era hanging bridge stretched over the crystal-clear Umngot River, adding a touch of heritage and scenic beauty to the experience.

5. Shnongpdeng

Attractions & Highlights:

- Camping by the River: Riverside camps with scenic beauty and peaceful surroundings.
- Adventure Activities: Kayaking, cliff jumping, snorkelling, and zip-lining over the Umngot River.
- Night Camping Experience: Sleep under the stars by the pristine waters of Shnongpdeng.

Mawlynnong Village

Day 1: Guwahati → Kaziranga | Dist: 203 km | 07–08 hrs

- After arriving in Guwahati, our representative will meet you at the airport.
- Drive to Kaziranga, and upon arrival, check into the hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 2: Kaziranga → Shillong | Dist 265 km | Time: 07-08 hrs

- Early morning, enjoy a jeep Safari in the Central Range (best for rhino sightings)
- · Breakfast at the hotel.
- And later depart for Shillong.

Night: Stay at the lodge/camps in Shillong

Day 3: Shillong → Shnongpdeng (Dawki) | Dist 88 km | Time: 02-03 hrs

- Wake up, have breakfast, and check out.
- Drive to Laitlum Canyons and enjoy the stunning views.
- Continue your journey to Shnongpdeng, making a scenic stop at the stunning Phe Phe Falls along the way.
- Upon arrival, check in to your riverside campsite by the crystal-clear Umngot River.
- Enjoy a bonfire, dinner, and an overnight stay.

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner Night: Stay in the tents at Dawki

Day 4: Water Sports and Phe-Phe Waterfall | Morning 10:00 am

- Begin your morning with a peaceful breakfast beside the crystal-clear waters of the Umngot River, surrounded by the serenity of nature.
- · Enjoy thrilling water activities, such as boating and cliff jumping.
- After lunch, head to Mawlynnong, Asia's cleanest village.

- Check out and set off to witness the awe-inspiring Nohkalikai Falls and the serene beauty of Lyngksiar Waterfalls.
- Explore the stunning Mawsmai Caves.
- After lunch, head towards Shillong and enjoy a relaxed evening exploring the vibrant streets of Police Bazaar, which is perfect for shopping and sampling local street food.

Night: Stay at the hotel in Shillong

Day 7: Departure | Dist 98 km | Time: 03-04 hrs

- Enjoy a delightful breakfast, then check out and start your drive towards Guwahati Airport.
- En route, pause at the picturesque Umiam Lake to soak in the views and capture some final memories of Meghalaya.
- Reach the airport by evening (book flights post 5:30 PM).
