En route to Kovalam, stop by the Jatayu Earth Centre to witness the world's largest bird sculpture and enjoy a cable car ride. In Kovalam, visit sun-kissed beaches like Hawa and Lighthouse Beach, and climb the lighthouse for stunning sea views. boating session at the picturesque Kundala Lake.
