Day 1: Arrival in Cochin – Transfer to Munnar | Cultural Evenings & Day; Scenic Stops

- Arrive in Kochi and head to Munnar.
- En route, enjoy a traditional Kerala meal, cross the scenic Neriamangalam Bridge, visit the beautiful Cheeyappara Waterfalls, and stop at Pottas Fun Farm for optional activities, such as ziplining and a fish spa.
- On reaching Munnar, check into your hotel. In the evening, witness a Kathakali dance and a Kalaripayattu martial arts performance.

Day 2: Munnar Sightseeing

- Start your day with a visit to Mattupetty Dam, where you can enjoy an optional jet ski ride.
- Stop at Pullu Medu Viewpoint for a chance to spot elephants in the wild, and take in the misty tea-covered hills at 2nd Mile Viewpoint.
- Visit top spots like Carmelagiri Elephant Park and the Tata Tea Museum, then end your day with a peaceful walk through the scenic Kanan Devan Tea Estate, sipping fresh local tea.

Day 3: Transfer to Thekkady – Wildlife, Spices & Day; Food Trails

- Check out and head to Thekkady.
- On arrival, enjoy a boat safari on Periyar Lake, where you can spot wildlife in Periyar



National Park. Explore a spice plantation to learn about Kerala's aromatic spices.

 After hotel check-in, head out on a self-guided Night Food Tour and savour authentic local dishes before returning to the hotel.

Day 4: Transfer to Alleppey – Backwater Houseboat Stay
