About This Trip •

A journey through Kerala, where every mile unfolds a blend of history, nature, and coastal elegance. The Kerala Package begins in the vibrant city of Kochi, steeped in colonial charm and cultural legacy. Explore architectural gems like the Mattancherry Palace, adorned with intricate murals narrating the epics of the Ramayana and Mahabharata. Witness the rhythmic movement of the iconic Chinese Fishing Nets, stroll through the quaint lanes of Fort Kochi, and admire historic landmarks such as St. Francis Church and the majestic Basilica of Santa Cruz.

As you move inland, the road to Munnar opens up a world of scenic wonder. En route, take in panoramic vistas of Periyar Lake from the Neriamangalam Bridge, pause at the cascading Cheeyappara and Valara Waterfalls, and add a bit of thrill to your journey with fun activities like ziplining at Pottas Fun Farm. Once in Munnar, the rolling hills and endless tea gardens welcome you to Kerala's highland heart. The Tata Tea Museum provides a fascinating glimpse into the region's famous tea heritage, while viewpoints like 2nd Mile and Pullu Medu treat you to breathtaking mountain views. Adventure and wildlife lovers can visit the Carmelagiri Elephant Park and take a peaceful walk through the serene Yellapatty Grasslands. The experience is beautifully capped off with a tranquil boating session at Kundala Lake, a picture-perfect spot surrounded by eucalyptus forests and blooming cherry blossoms during certain seasons.

From Munnar, continue to Thekkady, a destination known for its lush forests and rich biodiversity. The Kerala Package introduces you to hidden natural gems, such as the Chunayammakkal Waterfalls and the scenic Aruvikuzhi Viewpoint, which offers breathtaking views of the Kerala-Tamil Nadu border. Thekkady's highlight is undoubtedly the Periyar Wildlife Sanctuary, where you can spot elephants, tigers, and a diverse array of exotic birds. For an up-close experience, Elephant

Junction provides opportunities to interact with elephants. Delve into Kerala's spice heritage with a guided tour through a spice plantation, and explore local flavours on a delightful food walk.

Next, the tour continues to the backwaters of Alleppey, famously known as the 'Venice of the East.' A cruise aboard a traditional houseboat offers a chance to float through the tranquil canals and lagoons fringed with swaying palms and vibrant village life. The Kerala Package also includes visits to beautiful stretches of sand, such as Alleppey Beach and Marari Beach, ideal for sun-kissed relaxation. Ascend the Alleppey Lighthouse for panoramic coastal views, and take a quiet moment at the historic Mullakkal Rajarajeswari Temple, a nearly 500-year-old place of worship with deep cultural significance.

As the coastline beckons, the journey continues to Varkala, one of Kerala's most dramatic beach towns. Perched atop red laterite cliffs, Varkala Beach offers spectacular views of the Arabian Sea. At the same time, Kappil Beach is a unique spot where the sea meets the serene waters of Edava Lake, creating a stunning natural contrast. A visit to the ancient Janardhanaswamy Temple, believed to be over 2,000 years old, provides both spiritual resonance and picturesque vistas.

From Varkala, the road leads to Kovalam, a coastal retreat known for its crescent-shaped shores and surf-friendly waves. En route, stop at the Jatayu Earth Centre, where mythology meets adventure. Ride a cable car to reach the hilltop sculpture of Jatayu, the mythical bird from the Ramayana, said to be the world's largest bird sculpture. Once in Kovalam, unwind at the beach, visit the cliffside Azhimala Shiva Temple, and climb the Kovalam Lighthouse for sweeping views of the Arabian Sea. This leg of the Kerala Package blends beachside serenity with mythological significance and scenic charm.

Day 1: Arrival in Kochi & City Exploration

- Visit St. Francis Church, India's oldest European church, and the grand Santa Cruz Basilica.
