Optional elephant rides and Ayurvedic massages provide a cultural touch and holistic rejuvenation, key highlights of your Kerala Road Trip.

Next, head to Thekkady, Kerala's wildlife and spice haven. Here, cruise on Periyar Lake inside the Periyar Wildlife Sanctuary, keeping an eye out for elephants, wild boars, and vibrant birds. Engage with gentle giants at Elephant Junction and explore Kerala's spice secrets during a plantation tour, where you'll learn how cardamom, black pepper, and cinnamon are cultivated, a sensory delight during this Kerala Road Trip. After the backwaters, make your way to Kovalam, a charming beach town. Relax on the sun-kissed sands of Lighthouse Beach, wander through charming local shops, or ascend the historic Kovalam Lighthouse to enjoy sweeping views of the Arabian Sea. A visit to the nearby Azhimala Temple, featuring a towering 58-foot Shiva statue, blends mythological grandeur with spiritual serenity. Your final stop is Trivandrum, Kerala's cultural capital. You may also witness Bharatanatyam, a classical dance form that showcases Kerala's rich cultural heritage and artistic traditions.

Things to Do in Kerala Road Trip Package

Explore the Heritage of Fort Kochi (Cochin)

- Explore Kerala flavours with a Night Food Tour through Thekkady streets.

Cruise through the Backwaters of Alleppey

- Board a traditional houseboat (kettuvallam) and cruise through lush canals.
- Enjoy onboard meals cooked fresh by local chefs in Kerala.
- Try steering the houseboat with the captain's guidance.
- Watch daily village life unfold along the backwaters.

Unwind at Kovalam's Beaches & Temples

- Relax on the golden sands of Kovalam Beach and Lighthouse Beach.

- Climb the Kovalam Lighthouse for panoramic sea views (entry fee applies).
- Visit the Azhimala Shiva Temple with its massive 58-foot statue.
- Enjoy local seafood at beachside stalls and cafés.

Spiritual & Cultural Soak in Trivandrum

- Visit the Sree Padmanabhaswamy Temple – a rich cultural and spiritual site.
- Admire the Dravidian-style architecture and mural carvings.
- If lucky, catch a Bharatanatyam dance performance at the temple.
- Shop for handicrafts and silk saris at local markets before departure.

Itinerary •

Day 1: Arrival in Cochin & Transfer to Munnar | Cultural Evenings & Scenic Stops

- Arrive in Kochi and head to Munnar.

- On reaching Munnar, check into your hotel. In the evening, witness a Kathakali dance and a Kalaripayattu martial arts performance.

Day 2: Munnar Sightseeing

- Visit top spots like Carmelagiri Elephant Park and the Tata Tea Museum, then end your day with a peaceful walk through the scenic Kanan Devan Tea Estate, sipping fresh local tea.

A: Breakfast is included daily, and all meals are provided on board the houseboat. Lunch and dinner on other days are at your own expense, giving flexibility to explore Kerala's rich food culture.

Q: Is this Kerala Road Trip suitable for children and senior citizens?
