Q: Will I stay overnight on a houseboat in Alleppey, or is it a day cruise?

A: This itinerary includes a complete overnight stay on a private houseboat, offering a more immersive backwater experience with meals and accommodation onboard, one of the most memorable highlights of the Kerala Tour.

A: Yes, traditional attire is mandatory for temple visits in Kerala. Men should wear a dhoti (no shirt), and women should wear a saree with a dupatta. Western outfits, such as jeans or shorts, are not permitted inside the temple premises.

Q: How far is Kanyakumari from Kovalam, and how long is the day trip?

A: Kanyakumari is around 85 km from Kovalam. The round-trip takes a full day, including travel, ferry ride, and visits to key monuments and the temple.

Q: Is Bharatanatyam performance guaranteed at the Padmanabhaswamy Temple?

A: No, cultural performances are not scheduled daily and depend on temple festivals or special occasions. If available, it's a memorable bonus during your Kerala Tour.

Q: Are there any shopping opportunities during this Kerala Tour?
