FAQs •

Q: Is the road journey comfortable between destinations?

Q: Can I stay on a houseboat in Kumarakom instead of a hotel?

A: Yes, the itinerary can be customised for a houseboat stay upon request.

Q: Is Eravikulam National Park open year-round?

A: It's open from October to June, but closed during the monsoons and breeding season (February–March). Booking is recommended.

Q: Are local markets or handicraft shops included in the tour?

A: Yes, especially in Cochin and Thekkady, where you can shop for spices, tea, coir products, and souvenirs.

Q: Can I watch cultural shows like Kathakali or Kalaripayattu?

A: Yes, optional shows are available in Cochin and Thekkady and can be arranged locally.

Q: What wildlife can I see during the Periyar boat ride?

A: Common sightings include elephants, deer, wild boars, and water birds.

Q: Is this itinerary suitable for families and seniors?

A: Yes, it's family-friendly with moderate travel times and customizable activities.

Q: Are there any festivals during the tour?

A: Onam (Aug–Sep), Christmas, and New Year are great festive times. Neelakurinji blooms once every 12 years in Munnar.

A: Light clothing, a jacket for hill stations, walking shoes, sunscreen, rain gear (for monsoons), and mosquito repellent.

A: At least 30–45 days in advance is recommended during peak months (October to March) due to high demand for accommodations and park entries.

Q: Are guides included at sightseeing spots?

A: Local guides are not included by default but can be arranged upon request, especially at heritage sites such as the Dutch Palace or wildlife areas.

A: For Eravikulam National Park and Periyar Sanctuary, entry tickets are required and can be arranged in advance or at the gates.
