Day 1: Delhi to Manali | Dist: 529 km | Time: 12 to 16 hr | Altitude: 300 m to 2050 m

- Late at night, you'll board a semi-sleeper AC Volvo bus from Delhi, beginning your overnight
  journey to Manali.
- Sit back, relax, and enjoy a comfortable night's rest as you travel through the scenic route.

Day 2: Manali Local Sightseeing | Check-In: 11:00 am | Sightseeing: 2:00 pm to 6:00 pm



- Upon arriving in Manali, a cab will take you to your hotel for check-in.
- After freshening up, your sightseeing begins with a peaceful walk through Van Vihar and a visit to the local Museum.
- Next, you'll explore the centuries-old Hadimba Temple, followed by some leisure time soaking in the charm of Old Manali and the bustling Mall Road.

### Day 3: Visit Solang Valley | Sightseeing Time: 10:00 am to 6:00 pm

- After breakfast, leave for the stunning Solang Valley, a hub for adventure and breathtaking views.
- This spot is perfect for adventure lovers, offering activities such as skiing, paragliding, zip lining, yak riding, tube sliding, and quad biking (Kindly note that these activities come at an additional cost).
- As the day winds down, return to your hotel to relax and recharge.

# Day 4: Rohtang Pass and Koksar | Sightseeing Time: 10:00 am to 6:00 pm

- After a day filled with natural beauty and exploration, you'll return to your hotel in Manali by evening to unwind.

Day 5: Manali to Kasol via Kullu | Dist: 81 km | Time: 02 to 04 hr | Altitude: 2050 m to 1580 m

- After breakfast, you'll begin your journey to Kasol with a scenic drive through the beautiful Kullu Valley.
- Along the way, you'll have the option to stop for adventure activities like paragliding or river rafting (not included in the package).
- Once you arrive in Kasol, you'll visit the sacred Manikaran Temple, known for its hot springs and spiritual significance, before checking into your hotel for a restful evening.

Day 6: Depart for Delhi | Checkout: 11:00 am | Depart: 3:00 to 7:00 pm

- Wake up to the serene views of the Parvati Valley and enjoy a relaxed breakfast.
- After checking out of the hotel, you can choose to begin your return journey to Delhi.
- Spend some leisurely time exploring Kasol's charming cafes and riverside spots before boarding the evening bus back to Delhi.

### FAQs •

Q: What are the best things to do at Rohtang Pass?

A: Snow lovers can make the most of Rohtang Pass with skiing, snowboarding, sledging, and thrilling ATV rides. Photography, sightseeing of glaciers and mountains, and short treks are also popular. You can also explore nearby places like Koksar and Keylong.

Q: How much does it cost to visit Rohtang Pass?

A: The permit fee is ?500 plus ?50 congestion charges per vehicle. Taxi fares from Manali range from ?3,500 to ?6,000 depending on the vehicle and season. Snow activities and rentals cost extra.

Q: Do I need a permit to visit Rohtang Pass?



A: Yes, if you're travelling in a non-Himachal Pradesh (non-HP) registered vehicle, a permit is mandatory. Daily vehicle quotas are enforced, so booking early is important.

Q: How can I apply for the Rohtang Pass permit online?

A: You can apply online at https://rohtangpermits.nic.in. You'll need your ID proof, vehicle registration, and a valid pollution certificate. Choose the "Rohtang Pass" option during booking.

Q: Is Rohtang Pass open today?

A: Rohtang Pass is typically open from May to mid-November. For the current status, check the Himachal Tourism website, local news, or weather apps, as it may close due to snowfall or bad weather.

Q: How far is Rohtang Pass from Manali?

A: Rohtang Pass is approximately 50 kilometres from Manali. The drive typically takes 2 to 3 hours, depending on traffic and weather conditions.

Q: Can I see Rohtang Pass on a map?

A: Yes, you can search for "Rohtang Pass" on Google Maps. The common route is Manali? Marhi? Gulaba? Rohtang Pass via the Manali-Leh Highway (NH 3).

Q: What is the temperature at Rohtang Pass?

A: In summer, temperatures range from 5°C to 15°C. During autumn, it drops to 5°C to 10°C. The pass remains inaccessible in winter because of heavy snowfall.

**Q:** What is the weather like at Rohtang Pass?

A: The Weather is unpredictable and can change rapidly. Snowfall is possible even in summer. The best time to visit is May-June and September-October.

Q: What is the height or altitude of Rohtang Pass?

A: Rohtang Pass sits at an altitude of 3,978 meters (13,050 feet) above sea level.

**Q:** What areas does Rohtang Pass connect?

A: Rohtang Pass connects Kullu Valley (Manali) with Lahaul and Spiti Valley. It's part of the Leh-Manali Highway, providing access to Keylong and Leh.
