Itinerary •

Day 1: Delhi to Manali | Dist: 529 km | Time: 12 to 16 hr | Altitude: 300 m to 2050 m

- In the evening, you'll begin your journey to Manali with a comfortable overnight ride by cab or Volvo AC bus from Delhi.
- The drive takes about 10 to 13 hours, offering plenty of time to rest and soak in the scenic Himalayan landscapes along the way.

Day 2: Manali Local Sightseeing | Check-In: 11:00 am | Sightseeing: 2:00 pm to 6:00 pm

- On arrival in Manali, you'll be greeted by your driver, who will take you to your hotel for a smooth check-in.
- Once you've freshened up, start your day with a relaxing stroll through Van Vihar, then explore the Museum of Himachal Culture & Folk Art.
- Continue to the iconic Hadimba Temple, surrounded by deodar forests, and later, enjoy a stroll along Mall Road, soaking in the lively charm and local culture of Old Manali.

Day 3: Visit Solang Valley and Atal Tunnel | Sightseeing Time: 10:00 am to 6:00 pm

- On the way, you'll stop at the scenic Solang Valley, a popular hub for adventure lovers. Here, you can indulge in a variety of exciting activities (at your own expense), including paragliding, skiing, zip-lining, yak riding, tube sliding, and quad biking.

- Upon reaching Shimla, you'll check into your hotel and take some time to relax.
- Later, you can step out to explore the local market at your own pace, soaking in the colonial charm and lively atmosphere of this popular hill station.

Day 6: Shimla Local Sightseeing | Sightseeing Time: 11:00 am to 6:00 pm

- You will return to the hotel in the evening to spend the night.
