The next morning begins with a hearty breakfast, after which you'll head to the stunning Solang Valley. Famous for its adventure sports, Solang offers activities like zip-lining, paragliding, yak rides, and quad biking. With towering mountains and lush meadows as its backdrop, the valley is perfect for both thrill-seekers and nature enthusiasts. After an exciting day, return to your hotel for a relaxing night in Manali.

Following two memorable nights in Manali, your journey continues with a drive to Shimla, covering around 250 kilometres. The scenic route offers mesmerising views as you head to the charming capital of Himachal Pradesh. Arrive in the evening and check into your hotel, and unwind for a comfortable stay. Preparing for the adventures that lie ahead.

Begin the next day with a hearty breakfast before exploring Shimla's famous attractions, including Jakhu Temple, Mall Road, The Ridge, Christ Church, and Scandal Point. Later, travel to Kufri for winter activities like skiing and horse riding. In the afternoon, delve into the region's colonial history with visits to the Viceregal Lodge, Indian Institute of Advanced Studies, and the serene Botanical Gardens. Spend the night at your hotel in Shimla.



Enjoy your morning with a leisurely breakfast and explore Shimla's markets or revisit your favourite spots. In the evening, you'll be dropped off at the Shimla Bus Stand for an overnight journey back to Delhi, where you'll arrive the next morning carrying unforgettable memories of your Himachal adventure.

Places to visit in Manali Shimla Tour

Shimla

1. Mall Road

Shimla's lively Mall Road is a vibrant stretch filled with charming shops, cosy cafés, and inviting eateries, making it the perfect place for a relaxed stroll and local shopping. It's an ideal place for strolls, shopping, and enjoying views of the hills while savouring local snacks or sipping hot coffee.

2. The Ridge

The Ridge, a spacious open area in the heart of Shimla, offers breathtaking views of the surrounding hills and colonial architecture. Nearby, the neo-Gothic Christ Church stands tall as one of North India's oldest and most iconic churches. Its stained-glass windows and colonial charm make it a must-visit landmark, especially beautiful when lit up at night. Surrounded by charming colonial buildings, it's an ideal spot for sightseeing and photography, capturing the essence of Shimla's historic elegance and scenic beauty.

3. Jakhu Temple

Situated atop Jakhu Hill, Shimla's highest point, this historic Hanuman Temple offers breathtaking panoramic views of the town and surrounding mountains. Known for its serene spiritual ambience, the temple features a towering Hanuman statue and playful monkeys and can be accessed by either a trek or a cable car.

4. Christ Church

Christ Church, designed in striking neo-Gothic architecture, is among the oldest churches in North India and a prominent landmark in Shimla, known for its historic charm and beautifully stained-glass windows. Its stained-glass windows and colonial charm make it a must-visit landmark,



especially beautiful when lit up at night.

5. Kufri

Situated roughly 16 km from Shimla, Kufri is popular for winter snow activities, including skiing and tobogganing. In summer, it offers pony rides and beautiful hikes through pine-covered hills.

6. Indian Institute of Advanced Studies

Once the Viceregal Lodge, this grand building now hosts academic research. Surrounded by lush gardens, it's rich in history and colonial architecture, and offers guided tours of its preserved British-era interiors.

7. Tara Devi Temple

Tara Devi Temple, gracefully perched atop a peaceful hill near Shimla, offers a serene escape with sweeping views of the valley below, making it a perfect blend of spirituality and natural beauty. Surrounded by lush forests, it's an ideal spot for spiritual reflection and nature lovers alike.

8. Botanical Gardens

These gardens in Shimla offer a relaxing environment to enjoy a variety of native and exotic plant species. It's a tranquil spot perfect for nature walks, photography, and unwinding amidst greenery.

9. Annandale

Once a flat ground for polo and cricket, Annandale now features an Army Museum. Nestled amid dense forests, it offers a peaceful setting, historical exhibits, and occasional military demonstrations.

1. Hadimba Temple

A unique wooden temple dedicated to Hadimba Devi is located amidst cedar forests. This peaceful and historic site blends spiritual importance with natural beauty and is a key stop in Manali's cultural exploration.



2. Old Manali

Known for its laid-back vibe, Old Manali is full of quirky cafes, riverside spots, and boho charm. It's ideal for relaxing, meeting travellers, or exploring offbeat paths and small boutiques.

3. Solang Valley

Solang Valley, a favourite destination near Manali, is known for adventure sports like paragliding, ziplining, and ATV rides. In winter, it transforms into a snowy paradise ideal for skiing, combining stunning scenery with exciting activities.

4. Rohtang Pass (seasonal)

Open during summer, Rohtang Pass offers dramatic landscapes, snow-capped peaks, and thrilling rides through hairpin turns. It's popular for snow play and photography, but requires a permit to visit.

5. Vashisht Temple & Hot Springs

Located near Manali, this temple complex is famous for its natural hot-water springs, believed to have healing properties. The temple's serene surroundings and beautiful architecture create a truly spiritual and rejuvenating experience.

6. Manu Temple

Built in honour of the sage Manu, this serene temple in Old Manali is believed to be the only one of its kind. It's a short uphill walk and offers peace and spiritual ambience.

7. Van Vihar

A peaceful forest park in central Manali with towering deodar trees and a small boating lake. Ideal for families and nature lovers looking for a break from the busy town centre.



8. Dhungri Van Vihar

Located near Hadimba Temple, this forest area is ideal for nature walks and quiet reflection. Tall trees, chirping birds, and fresh air make it a soothing retreat in the heart of Manali.

9. Club House

The Club House in Manali is a riverside leisure zone offering indoor games, café options, and shopping. It's a good spot for relaxing and spending time with family or friends.

10. Mall Road, Manali

The main shopping street is filled with local shops, street food stalls, and cafes. It's perfect for buying woollens, souvenirs, and tasting Himachali delicacies while soaking in the town's lively atmosphere.
