Day 1: Delhi to Manali | Dist: 529 km | Time: 12 to 16 hr | Altitude: 300 m to 2050 m

- If you choose to travel by cab, you'll head straight to Manali by road.
- Otherwise, you'll board a Volvo bus later in the evening for a scenic overnight journey.
- It will take approximately 10 to 14 hours to reach Manali the next day.

Day 2: Manali Local Sightseeing | Check-In: 11:00 am | Sightseeing Time: 2:00 pm to 6:00 pm

- Upon arriving in Manali, you'll check into your hotel.
- Later in the afternoon, a cab will take you to visit popular attractions, including Mall Road, Hadimba Temple, Van Vihar, Old Manali, the Museum, and the Clubhouse.
