The next day, you can take a trip to the Kullu Valley, where you can opt for river rafting on the Beas River or paragliding over lush green valleys (optional activities). It's a breathtaking way to experience the raw beauty of Himachal.

After days filled with exploration and adventure, the trip concludes with a relaxed return to Delhi, carrying memories of snow-capped peaks, vibrant local culture, and the thrill of the great outdoors!

## Itinerary •

Day 1: Delhi to Manali | Dist: 529 km | Time: 12 to 16 hr | Altitude: 300 m to 2050 m

- You will board your bus at the designated pickup point: either Kashmere Gate or Majnu Ka Tilla.
- The journey will take approximately 10 to 14 hours, depending on traffic and road conditions.

## Day 2: Manali Local Sightseeing | Check-In: 11:00 am | Sightseeing: 2:00 pm to 6:00 pm

- Upon arriving in Manali, a cab will take you to your hotel.
- After freshening up, you'll head out in the afternoon to visit Hadimba Temple, Old Manali, Van Vihar, the Club House, and the Museum.
- In the evening, you'll have free time to explore Mall Road before returning to the hotel.

## Day 3: Visit Solang Valley | Sightseeing Time: 10:00 am to 6:00 pm

- After enjoying your morning tea and breakfast, you'll head out to explore Solang Valley.
- Here, you can choose to book a variety of adventure activities (not included in the package) such as ziplining, paragliding, skiing, yak riding, quad biking, and more.
- Later, you will visit the renowned Atal Tunnel.
- After an action-packed day, you'll return to your hotel in the evening to unwind and relax.

## Day 4: Visit Kullu Valley | Sightseeing Time: 10:00 am to 6:00 pm

- Today, you'll head to Kullu, where you'll have the option to experience paragliding or river rafting (activities not included in the package).

- In the afternoon, you'll return to your hotel in Manali to relax.

- After a delicious breakfast, check out of your hotel around 11:00 a.m.
- Following checkout, a cab will either drive you directly to Delhi or drop you off at the Volvo bus stand, where you can board your bus back to Delhi.

## FAQs •

**Q:** What is included in a Manali trip package from Delhi?

**A:** Most packages include round-trip Volvo/cab transport, hotel stay (2–4 nights), sightseeing tours (Hadimba Temple, Solang Valley, Kullu), and meals (usually breakfast and dinner). Activities like paragliding or rafting are generally extra.

**Q:** How much does a Manali trip cost for 3 days?

**A:** A 3-day trip typically costs ₹4,500 to ₹8,000 per person, depending on the mode of transport and hotel category. It usually includes local sightseeing and 1 day for Solang or Kullu.

**Q:** What is the cost of a Manali trip for two people?

**A:** For two people, expect to spend ₹10,000 to ₹22,000 total for a 3–5 day trip. The cost depends on the hotel type, transportation (Volvo vs. private cab), and any additional activities.

**Q:** What is the average cost of a 5-day Manali trip?

**A:** A 5-day Manali trip usually costs ₹6,000 to ₹15,000 per person. This includes stay, transport, food, and sightseeing. Adventure activities and shopping are additional.

**Q:** How much will a 7-day Manali trip cost?

**A:** A 7-day trip can range from ₹10,000 to ₹25,000 per person, especially if you add destinations like Kasol, Tosh, or Rohtang (in season).

**Q:** How to plan a Manali trip from Mumbai?

**A:** Fly to Delhi or Chandigarh, then take a Volvo/cab to Manali. Look for Mumbai-to-Manali packages that include flights, hotel, and transport. Total cost ranges from ₹12,000 to ₹28,000 per person.

**Q:** Is there a Manali trip package from Bangalore?

**A:** Yes, you can fly to Delhi and continue to Manali by road. Packages from Bangalore start at around ₹15,000 and increase based on hotel class and inclusions.

**Q:** How can I travel from Hyderabad to Manali?

**A:** Take a flight to Delhi or Chandigarh, then board a cab or Volvo to Manali. Packages from Hyderabad range from ₹12,000 to ₹25,000 for 5-6 days.

**Q:** What's included in a Kullu-Manali trip?

**A:** It typically includes sightseeing in Manali, adventure activities in Solang Valley, and river rafting or paragliding in Kullu. Duration is usually 4–5 days.

**Q:** What is the cost of a Kullu-Manali trip?

**A:** Around ₹7,000 to ₹14,000 per person for 4–5 days, excluding high-end hotels or flights. Adventure activities cost extra.

**Q:** How far is Manali from Delhi, and how to get there?

**A:** Manali is about 530 km from Delhi. You can take an overnight Volvo bus (12–14 hrs) or a private cab. The road passes through scenic hills and valleys.
