As you arrive in Bir in the early morning hours, you'll settle into your hotel and begin exploring the area's spiritual and cultural charm. Highlights include a visit to the Nyingyang Monastery, the intellectually enriching Deer Park Institute, renowned for its focus on Indian philosophy, and the serene Palpung Sherabling Monastic Centre. After soaking in Bir's meditative atmosphere, your journey continues through the lush, pine-covered landscapes of Barot Valley and the quaint village of Badagaon. The route offers breathtaking views before leading you to the remote and peaceful Rajgundha Valley, where you'll spend the night in a camp or hotel nestled in nature. Surrounded by untouched beauty, it's the perfect place to disconnect and unwind. The next morning takes you to Billing, one of Asia's best paragliding destinations. There, you'll take off with a professional pilot for a thrilling flight over the Dhauladhar ranges and the stunning Kangra Valley below (paragliding cost not included in the package). After landing, you'll return to Bir, where you'll have time to relax before boarding your overnight bus back to Delhi. This immersive trip offers a perfect balance of spiritual exploration, offbeat nature experiences, and high-flying adventure in the heart of Himachal Pradesh.

Things to do in Bir Billing and Rajgundha

1. Trekking & Nature Walks

The classic trek from Bir/Billing or Barot to Rajgundha Village, passing through alpine meadows,

Deodar and Rhododendron forests, mountain streams, and river crossings over wooden bridges..

Explore smaller trails, such as Chaina Pass or Palachak, which offer breathtaking panoramic views. Advanced hikers can attempt the challenging Thamsar Pass trek, connecting to Bara Bhangal with alpine lakes and dramatic vistas at 4,750 m

2. Stargazing Under the Milky Way

Rajgundha is famous for its pristine night skies. With significantly less pollution, the night sky reveals the Milky Way in all its glory, identifiable planets, and even satellites such as the ISS.

Camping here is an excellent way to soak in the night sky around a bonfire under the stars

3. Explore Chhota Manali

Venture into the small pine-forest enclave called Chhota Manali, dubbed for its resemblance to Manali's forests. It's perfect for serene walks, book reading, or simply breathing in the pine-scented air

4. Riverside Relaxation

Hike to the banks of the Uhl River, just minutes from the village. Dip your toes in the icy water, lounge on sun-warmed rocks, or take in the ambient sound of flowing water and bird song

5. Camping & Village Life

Stay overnight in basic camps or traditional mud-house guesthouses, priced affordably from ₹500–₹1,500 per night

Interact with semi-nomadic locals, learn about their customs, and observe traditional Himachali stone and mud architecture

6. Barot Valley Activities & Paragliding

Enjoy trout fishing in Barot Valley, where fishing licenses are available at reasonable rates

Try paragliding from Billing, which is near Asia's second-highest paragliding site, providing an exhilarating aerial view of the Dhauladhar range (optional activity beyond local valley limits)

7. Off-Roading, Yoga, & Photography

- Take on off-road drives along the Billing–Rajgundha stretch for an adrenaline rush

- Practice meditation or yoga in the crisp, peaceful ambience of the valley
- Capture vivid landscapes, wildlife, and local life with your camera, ideal for photography enthusiasts of all types

8. Best Time to Visit Rajgundha Valley

Plan your journey between March and June or September and October for lush green landscapes and pleasant weather. Winter (Dec–Feb) brings heavy snowfall, closing roads and trekking routes; most locals migrate seasonally during this period.

Itinerary •

Day 1: Delhi to Bir Billing | Dist: 516 km | Time: 10 to 12 hrs | Altitude: 300 m to 1525 m

- You will be picked up from Delhi at night in a comfortable Volvo bus or private cab, beginning your scenic overnight journey to Bir.
- The drive covers a distance of approximately 11 to 12 hours, allowing you to rest while you travel through the tranquil landscapes of Himachal Pradesh.

Night: Journey by Volvo Bus or Cab

Day 2: Arrive at Bir Billing | Arrival Time: 06 am to 08 am | Check-In Time: 11:00 am

- After reaching Bir Billing, you will check into the hotel.
- After breakfast, you will visit Nyingyang Monastery, followed by an exploration of the Deer Park Institute, known for its teachings on Indian wisdom traditions.
- You'll also experience the serene atmosphere of the Palpung Sherabling Monastic Centre.

Meals: Dinner

Night: Stay at the hotel in Bir

Day 3: Bir to Barot to Rajgundha | Dist: 80 km | Time: 03 to 05 hrs | Altitude: 1525 m to 2712 m

- After breakfast, you will be picked up from Bir and driven towards Rajgundha.
- Passing through the picturesque Barot Valley and Badagaon village. The journey offers beautiful views of lush forests and mountain scenery.
- By evening, you will arrive at Rajgundha Valley, where you'll check into a camp or hotel and unwind in the serene, offbeat charm of the region.

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Night: Stay at the hotel/camp in Rajgundha

Day 4: Rajgundha to Bir Billing and Depart | Dist: 30 km | Time: 03 to 05 hrs | Altitude: 2712 m to 1525 m

- After breakfast, begin your scenic drive to Billing, the renowned paragliding take-off site.
- Upon arrival, you'll take off with your pilot for an exhilarating paragliding experience, soaring over the stunning Dhauladhar ranges and lush valleys. *(Please note: Paragliding cost is not included in the package.)*
- After landing, you'll return to Bir, where you'll have some time to relax before boarding your overnight bus back to Delhi, concluding your memorable mountain adventure.

Q: What is Rajgundha Valley?

A: Rajgundha Valley is a hidden, offbeat gem located near Bir Billing, Himachal Pradesh. Renowned for its breathtaking natural beauty, serene ambience, and rewarding trekking trails.

Q: Where is Rajgundha Valley located?

A: Rajgundha Valley is situated at an altitude of approximately 2,700 meters, nestled between Barot Valley and Billing, near the renowned paragliding hub of Bir in Himachal Pradesh.

Q: What's the distance of the Bir to Rajgundha trek?

A: The trek is approximately 12-14 km long, taking around 4-6 hours to complete, depending on your pace and physical endurance.

Q: How is the Bir to Rajgundha trek experience?

A: The trail winds through a combination of forest paths, meadows, and mountain views. It's suitable for beginners, with gentle ascents and minimal altitude gain.

Q: Are there hotels in Rajgundha Valley?

A: Accommodation is basic, but charming camps, homestays, and eco-lodges are common. There are no commercial hotels; this keeps the area serene and eco-friendly.

Q: Is there a Zostel in Rajgundha Valley?

A: While Zostel does not currently operate directly in Rajgundha, Zostel Bir is nearby and serves as a great base before or after your trek.

Q: What is the distance from Bir to Rajgundha?

A: By trekking: ~12–14 km (4–6 hours) and By road: ~80 km via Barot (3–5 hours, longer but drivable route)

Q: How to travel from Bir to Rajgundha?

A: You can trek directly via Billing or drive a longer route via Barot and Badagaon. Trekkers often camp overnight or return the same day.
