Your Darjeeling experience includes everything the hill town is famous for, from witnessing the unforgettable sunrise at Tiger Hill, where Mt. Kanchenjunga glows with morning light, to riding the world-renowned Darjeeling Himalayan Railway, a UNESCO World Heritage toy train that loops through scenic hills. From Darjeeling, the journey continues to Pelling, a peaceful town nestled in West Sikkim, known for its natural and cultural treasures. In Pelling, witness panoramic views of the Kanchenjunga Ranges, walk the thrilling glass-bottom Sikkim Skywalk, admire the towering 137-foot Chenrezig statue, and delve into Sikkim's history with a visit to the Rabdentse Ruins and Pemayangtse Monastery, one of the oldest and most revered monastic sites in the region.

The trip then takes you to Gangtok, Sikkim's bustling yet serene capital city, passing by Ravangla's Buddha Park, where the magnificent 130-ft Shakyamuni Buddha overlooks manicured gardens and the distant Himalayas. In Gangtok, immerse yourself in high-altitude beauty with visits

to the sacred Tsomgo Lake, a glacial lake that reflects the sky in magical hues, and the revered Baba Mandir, dedicated to the spirit of an Indian Army soldier. For those seeking a once-in-a-lifetime experience, a visit to Nathula Pass, the Indo-China border post, can be arranged (subject to availability).

The final leg of the journey takes you to Kalimpong, a lesser-explored gem known for its serenity, panoramic viewpoints, and spiritual landmarks. As you wind your way along the Teesta River, Kalimpong welcomes you with sights like the Zang Dhok Palri Monastery, Jelepla Viewpoint, and the elevated Deolo Hill, which offers panoramic views of surrounding river valleys and distant snow-capped peaks.

Whether you're travelling with family, your partner, or a group of friends, this itinerary offers a perfect mix of natural beauty, cultural richness, and spiritual depth. Itinerary •

Day 1: Arrive at Bagdogra Airport/NJP Railway Station and transfer to Darjeeling

- Upon arrival at Bagdogra (IXB) Airport or New Jalpaiguri (NJP) Railway Station, you will be greeted by our representative and transferred to Darjeeling.

- Take a picturesque drive, soaking in breathtaking views of the Himalayas and lush tea plantations, before arriving at your hotel for a restful overnight stay.

Day 2: Darjeeling Sightseeing Day

- Your day begins at 4 AM with a visit to Tiger Hill for a stunning sunrise view of Mt. Kanchenjunga.
- After breakfast, enjoy a UNESCO World Heritage toy train ride, including a stop at Ghum Station and Batasia Loop, offering panoramic views of Darjeeling and the Himalayas.
- Visit the Himalayan Mountaineering Institute, Tenzing Rock, and the Padmaja Naidu Zoological Park (closed on Thursdays).
- Take a ropeway ride over tea plantations with views of snow-capped peaks, then explore the Japanese Temple and Peace Pagoda.
- Return to your hotel in Darjeeling for a comfortable overnight stay.

Day 3: Darjeeling to Pelling

- After breakfast in Darjeeling, you will be transferred to Pelling. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel and take a half-day sightseeing tour.
- Visit India's highest Skywalk with views of the Kanchenjunga Ranges and the 137-foot Chenrezig statue.
- Explore the Rabdentse Ruins to learn about Sikkim's history and seek blessings at the Pemayangtse Monastery.

- Head back to your hotel in Pelling for a comfortable overnight stay.

Day 4: Pelling to Gangtok

- After breakfast, board your transfer to Gangtok, the capital of Sikkim.
- En route, stop at Ravangla to visit Buddha Park, home to the 130-ft Shakyamuni Buddha Statue and scenic gardens with views of the Himalayas.
- Continue the journey to Gangtok, passing through picturesque roads with views of the Teesta River.
- Upon arrival, check in to your hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 5: Explore Local Gangtok

Day 6: Gangtok to Kalimpong

- After breakfast, transfer to Kalimpong, an offbeat hill station in West Bengal.
- En route, enjoy scenic views along the Teesta River.
- Upon arrival, check in to your hotel and begin sightseeing.
- Visit the Zang Dhok Palri Monastery, followed by the Jelepla viewpoint, for views of the Teesta, Relli, and Reang rivers.
- Conclude the day with a visit to Deolo Hill, the highest point in Kalimpong.
- Return to your hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 7: Departure. Kalimpong to Bagdogra Airport/ NJP Station.

- After breakfast in Kalimpong, transfer to Bagdogra Airport (IXB) or New Jalpaiguri Railway Station (NJP).
- Upon drop-off at the airport or station for your onward journey, your tour concludes.

FAQs •

Q: Do I need a special permit to enter Sikkim as an Indian citizen?

A:

No permit is required for Indian nationals to enter Sikkim. However, permits are mandatory for visiting protected areas like Nathula Pass, North Sikkim (Lachen/Lachung), and Tsomgo Lake.

Q: Can I experience snowfall during this trip?

A:

Yes, you may witness snowfall at Tsomgo Lake or Nathula Pass, especially between

December and February. However, snowfall isn't guaranteed during other months.

Q: What is the altitude sickness risk in this Sikkim trip itinerary?

A:

Most places are at a moderate altitude, but Tsomgo Lake (12,000 ft) and Nathula Pass (14,000 ft) can cause mild altitude symptoms like breathlessness or headaches.

Q: Is Nathula Pass open throughout the year?

A:

No, Nathula Pass remains closed on Mondays and Tuesdays, and may shut anytime due to weather. Access is subject to permit availability and road conditions.

Q: Can I include a toy train ride in my Darjeeling itinerary?

A:

Yes, the Darjeeling Himalayan Railway (UNESCO) joy ride is part of most itineraries. Booking is recommended, especially in peak season.

Q: Can you see Mount Kanchenjunga during this trip?

A:

Absolutely. Tiger Hill in Darjeeling provides a breathtaking panoramic view of Mt. Kanchenjunga, especially stunning on clear mornings at sunrise.

Q: How many monasteries are included in the itinerary?

A:

This tour covers iconic monasteries like Pemayangtse Monastery (Pelling), Rumtek Monastery (optional), Japanese Temple (Darjeeling), and Zang Dhok Palri Monastery (Kalimpong).

Q: Can I use public transport during the tour?

Explore MG Marg in Gangtok, Mall Road in Darjeeling, and Kalimpong markets for souvenirs like prayer flags, local woollens, teas, spices, and handicrafts.

Q: Can I combine this trip with North Sikkim (Lachen-Lachung)?

Yes, this package can be extended to include North Sikkim's popular attractions like Yumthang Valley, Zero Point, and Gurudongmar Lake with a few additional days.
