Gangtok's local highlights continue with a visit to the serene Dro-Dul Chorten, where spinning prayer wheels and monk chants create an atmosphere of peace. Enjoy the panoramic views of the

snow-draped Kanchenjunga range from Tashi View Point and explore the quaint temples of Ganesh Tok and Hanuman Tok, perched high above the city with sweeping vistas. End your day at the refreshing Ban Jhakri Falls, where forest trails and cascading waters offer a nature escape right near the town.

The next phase of your Sikkim holiday tour leads you to Darjeeling, often referred to as the "Queen of the Hills." Later, dive into mountaineering history at the Himalayan Mountaineering Institute and marvel at rare species like the Red Panda at the Padmaja Naidu Himalayan Zoological Park.

The Darjeeling Ropeway provides stunning aerial views of sprawling tea gardens and mountain ridges, making it a favourite for photography and nature enthusiasts. Wrap up the day at the tranquil Japanese Temple and Peace Pagoda, spiritual landmarks that offer both cultural depth and meditative silence.

As your journey concludes, enjoy a scenic return to Bagdogra Airport or NJP Railway Station with your heart full of unforgettable memories, snow-capped peaks, sacred shrines, vibrant markets, and serene sunrises, all part of this magical Darjeeling and Sikkim trip. Whether you're booking a family getaway, a couple's retreat, or a solo Himalayan escape, this Sikkim Darjeeling holiday package is crafted to offer a rich and seamless travel experience.

Itinerary •

Day 1: Arrival at Bagdogra | Transfer to Gangtok

- Upon arrival at Bagdogra Airport (IXB) or New Jalpaiguri Railway Station (NJP), you will be greeted by our representative and transferred to Gangtok.
- Enjoy a brief stop at Triveni View Point, where the Teesta and Rangeet rivers converge.

- Continue your scenic drive through winding roads alongside the Teesta River.
- Explore MG Marg at your leisure in the evening before checking into your hotel for an overnight stay in Gangtok.

Day 2: Explore Gangtok; Tsomgo Lake, Baba Mandir and Nathula Pass

- Then, continue to Baba Mandir, a tribute to Indian Army soldier Baba Harbhajan Singh.
- For those interested, hire a taxi to visit Nathula Pass, the Indo-China border post (subject to availability and extra cost).
- Return to Gangtok for an overnight stay.

Day 3: Gangtok Local Sightseeing

- Visit the various attractions in and around Gangtok after breakfast at the hotel.
- Commence your sightseeing with Dro-Dul Chorten and enjoy the silence and prayer recitations there.
- Then, head over to Tashi View Point and get mesmerised by the vision of Kanchenjunga and Siniolchu Peaks.
- Ganesh Tok and Hanuman Tok are two beautiful hilltop temples that give views of the

beauty of Gangtok and the range of Kanchenjunga.

- End the day at Ban Jhankri Falls, where you can relax or indulge in adventure activities.
- Head back to the hotel and spend the night in Gangtok.

Day 4: Gangtok to Darjeeling

- After breakfast at your hotel in Gangtok, you will be transferred to Darjeeling, a scenic hill station in the Himalayas.

- Enjoy a ropeway ride over tea plantations and visit the serene Japanese Temple and Peace Pagoda.
- End the day with an overnight stay in Darjeeling.

Day 6: Departure, Darjeeling to Bagdogra Airport/ NJP Station

Yes, the Darjeeling Himalayan Railway (Toy Train) is a UNESCO World Heritage ride and is part of the sightseeing experience from Darjeeling to Ghum via Batasia Loop.
